## How to contact the Police

### By Phone

Call 999 if:

- In an emergency situation where a serious offences is in progress or has just been committed.
- Someone is in immediate danger or harm
- Property is in danger of being damaged
- A serious disruption to the public is likely

In an emergency if you are deaf or hard of hearing use our textphone service on 18000

Call 101 for:

- All non-emergency enquiries.

In a non-emergency situation if you're deaf or hard of hearing, use our textphone service on 18001 101

### Digital 101

Digital 101 means that Members of the public can now report non-emergency incidents or make general enquires to Staffordshire Police through the force's main Facebook and Twitter accounts.

The service is available to the public 7am – midnight, seven days a week.
